Throughout the past 129 years, Willard Sorority has maintained its distinguished title as the nation's oldest and largest local sorority. Since our founding in 1889, active members and alumnae of Willard Sorority have continued to strive for perfect womanhood by focusing on the betterment of their character, scholarship, sisterhood, commitment, and service to the community.

This past spring the women of Willard had the second highest term GPA of 3.65 and tied for the highest cumulative GPA of 3.63. Four members participated in the CHIP program and 4 members studied abroad. We challenge each member to devote 12 hours of their time to cause they are passionate about and the whole house supports our annual philanthropy events, Rock-A-Thon, Build Your Own Burrito, Relay for Life and S'more Local Love.

Willard Foundation Report

Willard Foundation was formed as a 501(c)(3) in 2005 and is ran by a group of nine Willard Alumni that make up the Board of Directors. Willard Foundation is funded by the generous donations provided by our network of Willard Alumni. These donations allow for the Foundation to offer scholarship opportunities in both the Fall and Spring semesters. Last year we were blessed with an extremely generous donation from an alum and we will work to make the Foundation sustainable with this person's generosity.

Scholarships are primarily based on financial need, however GPA is strongly considered. The applicants are asked to write an essay to touch on the extent of their need and to reflect on the Five Willard Pillars of Perfect Womanhood that they represent very well: Character, Commitment, Scholarship, Sisterhood and Service. The scholarships are to be used for the purpose of tuition, and are made payable to NWU.

We are happy to announce that in the Fall of 2017 the Foundation was able to provide \$9,250 in scholarship funds to 17 Active Women and this Spring we were able to provide \$3,750 in scholarships funds to 16 Active Women.
